ALTER-Net is a thriving Europe-wide, self-supporting network of 26 public and private research and outreach organizations, aiming to integrate and improve European biodiversity research.

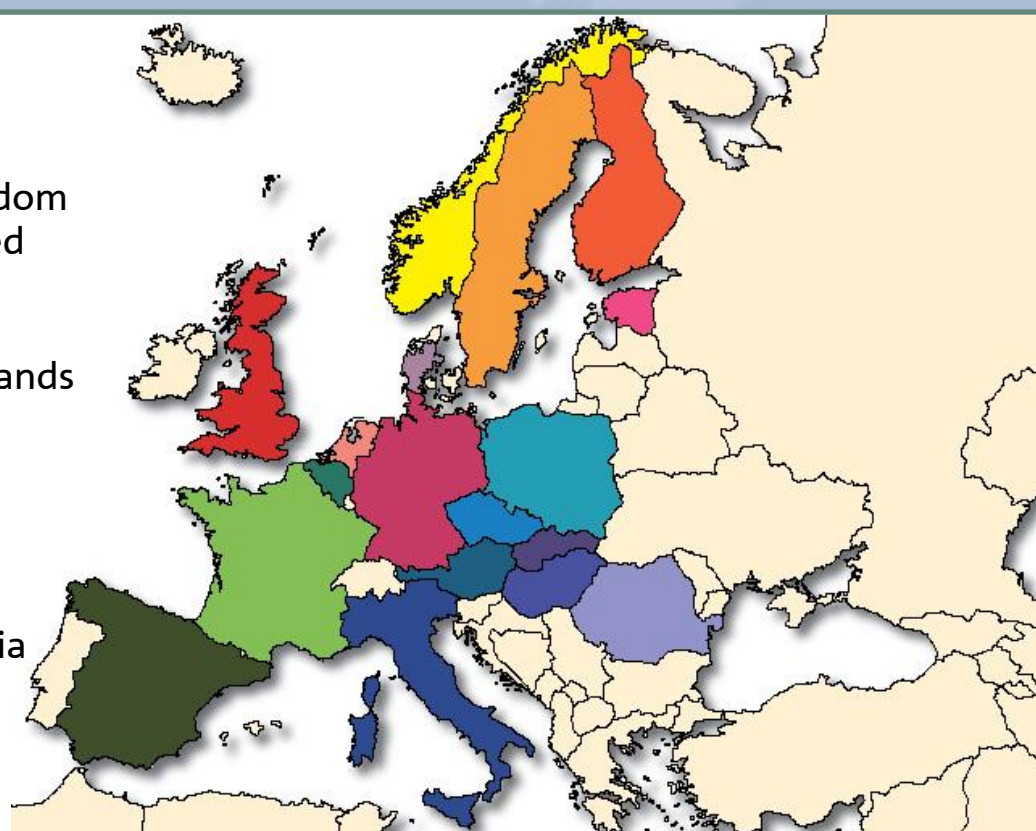
